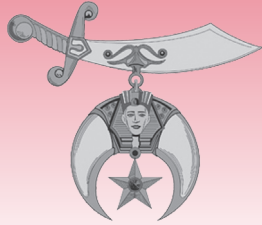

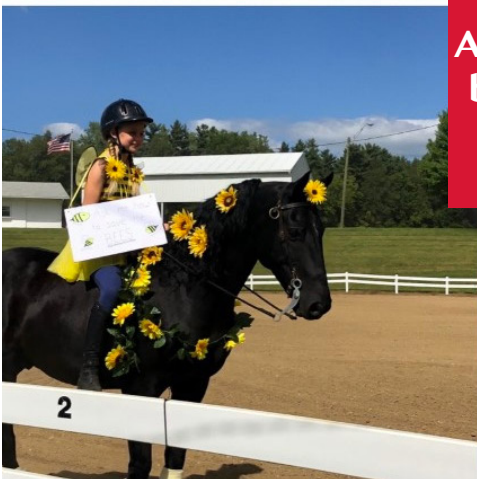

BRAYDEN'S STORY: *How Shriners Hospitals help a young man fight back after near-death experience*

After a devastating car crash,

18-year-old Brayden was left with severe injuries and burns over 85% of his body.

He spent six months at a prominent hospital, heavily sedated and with little chance of recovery. When that hospital discharged him for hospice services, his family contacted Shriners Hospitals for Children® — Cincinnati, where the staff's exceptional skill and family-centered care not only saved Brayden's life, it gave him the chance to live his best life.



The difference in care was instantly apparent. "Here we use a team approach to treat our patients," said Cindy DeSerna, manager of care management for Cincinnati Shriners Hospital. "Brayden needed so much. Because he was legally an adult, no one at the previous hospital made him do the hard work when he became frustrated. We knew he would need all the help our team could give him." With precise nutrition, skilled skin grafting and proper dressing changes, Brayden began to heal. He was soon able to work with the hospital's occupational/physical therapists to regain his independence.

Within seven weeks, he was well enough for a quick visit home before heading to the Houston Shriners orthopaedic hospital to further improve his mobility.

Brayden continues treatment at both hospitals, and though his challenges are far from over, the life changing care of Shriners Hospitals for Children is giving him the tools and treatment to work toward a positive future.

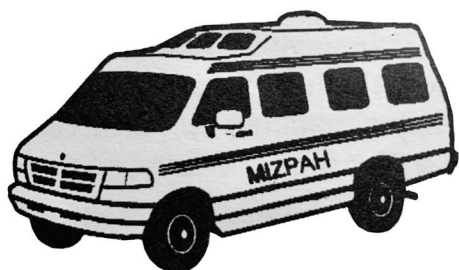
