



### **Fips For Successful Events**

If you are a club or unit president please contact the Mizpah office and let them know. We need your contact information so we can update the Mizpah website. When a new Noble comes in and marks a box that he may be interested in your club/unit, we take the contact information from the Mizpah website. Does not look good to have obsolete information on the web. In fact it can drive people away from you.

Social Media, It is not just Facebook. It is all forms of electronic information. When you have an event planned, the first thing you should do is get it on the Mizpah Calendar. That way everyone sees it and you are not stepping on someone else's day, and they are not stepping on yours. Calendar management comes from the top.

Once your date is on the Calendar it is easy to create what is called a drip campaign. In the case of Facebook, it's just a series of posts that announce and remind people of your event. Timely reminders are helpful in keeping your event in front of people that may make the decision to attend at the last minute.

Driving attendance. Just because you have a great idea does not mean everyone is showing up. Great events start with planning early. They all have a method of keeping that event in front of their audience and ways to follow up to make sure it is attended. Again, the use of Facebook and even Constant Contact emailing can help in this. Call teams have also proved successful. Personal invites can also help.

If you can, set aside some budget for marketing. Swag is always great. You can obtain Mizpah marketing items from Shriners International at no cost (usually). If you need help, contact the Recorder or Membership.
