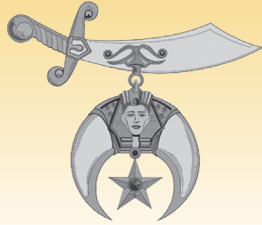

# Recorder's Message ...

Hello Nobles,

I hope everyone had a great summer. I wanted to let you know about a few things to look for in the next couple of months.

Due's cards will be sent out on September 1, 2022. There will be a few changes this year. One thing that will not change is the cost to be a noble. No increases this year from Imperial or our Temple. This may change next year if our costs continue to grow.

Nobles will be able to pay their bills online this year. If you get into your Webfez account, you will be asked if you want to pay online. There will be a 4% processing fee. You do not have to use this option; you can still pay the way you have always paid. This just adds a new level of convenience.

Imperial is moving away from membership cards. They want you to develop a Webfez account to manage your membership. Within this account, they have a membership card that you can download and have it available on your phone. When you come into a meeting, you just bring up the card and it will be scanned to determine your status. You will no longer have to always carry your card, it will be on your phones. We do realize that not all of you have a smart phone and some of you are not good with computers. We will have a limited number of stickers available at the office for people in that situation. We can also help you set up your account and download your card. Just let the office know you need help.

Within the Webfez account you will be able to see everything that you have done as a Shriner, Clubs that you have been in, dues that you have paid, personal information. You will be able to change your address or phone number.

This is a great tool, and we will be sending some additional information out on how to create your account.

# Proposed Bylaw Change For Mizpah ...

The August stated meeting introduced the first reading of a proposed bylaw change for Mizpah. This proposed change will be read again at the September stated meeting. This article is the printed notification that is required per Imperial bylaw.

The current bylaw reads:

Article 5.2 Dues (a)

Suspension for Nonpayment

- A member who is two years in arrears on his dues is suspended, pursuant to the procedure recited in the bylaws of Shriners International.

The proposed change is:

Article 5.2 Dues (a)

Suspension for Nonpayment

- A member who is one year in arrears on his dues is suspended, pursuant to the procedure recited in the bylaws of Shriners International.

As you know, every year we read the names of those Nobles that will be suspended for non-payment of their dues. This will not change. The Imperial procedure is:

- **§ 323.11 Suspension for Nonpayment of Dues.**
- (a) **Suspension or Remission.** A temple may not carry a member on the books who is more than 2 years in arrears. The temple must either suspend him or remit his dues.
- (b) **Procedure for Suspension.** A Noble may be suspended for nonpayment of dues in the following manner:
  - (1) He must be notified by first-class mail that he is in arrears;
  - (2) He must be given an opportunity to be heard;
  - (3) He must be admitted to the temple for this purpose even though he is in arrears; and
  - (4) A majority of members present at a stated meeting must vote to suspend him.
- (c) **Effective Date.** Whenever adopted, any order of suspension shall be effective as of December 31 of the last year of the delinquency

Why are we trying to change the bylaws??

Simply put, to save money. Every year we carry a Noble we owe Imperial the per capita and the hospital fee. When we carry 20-40 it's not a big number. However we now face carrying over 100 Nobles over into a delinquent status. It is about \$3500. When we carry them again it's another \$3500.

Could we pay this? Yes.

Do we need to? Well that's why it has been proposed and why we are talking about it.

What has been done? Good question! Let us start with the assumption that a Noble knows he has dues to pay. Every year he has dues do pay. We have not established any paid up for life programs. Maybe sometime in the future we will but, right now we do not. So right now, everyone owes dues.

We have established a hardship and distress program. Not one Noble that has applied for it has been denied.

We have set up calling teams. We have email campaigns. We have Imperial mailings. We have looked for people on Facebook, Linked-in and even public records searched. Unfortunately, we have also had to search Obits. We have given the units and clubs rosters of Nobles in their clubs that owe dues and asked them to help keep Nobles in their clubs. This is one of the reasons why the Records office needs the rosters of your members. BTW- If you would like to help call, please contact me!!

This is a way to clean up the delinquency roster. If a Noble wants to come back the Recorder has the restoration program. It also puts us on the same schedule as Indiana Grand Lodge with an annual dues renewal policy.

Here is a bonus!!! You can pay these dues online. Yes, and you can even break it down to smaller payments. Paying your dues through WebFez has NEVER been easier. You just have to log in and do it.

This is a cost savings measure. At a time when every dollar counts it is time to account for these.

This was briefed at the last stated meeting and will be briefed again in September. Each Noble on the suspension list will also receive first class mail regarding this and will be allowed entrance to be heard in September and October stated meetings. We do not want to turn any Noble away.

I am available for questions and discussion. Regardless of what the outcome is, the Membership team will continue to do the best we can to make all Nobles and their families welcome and involved.

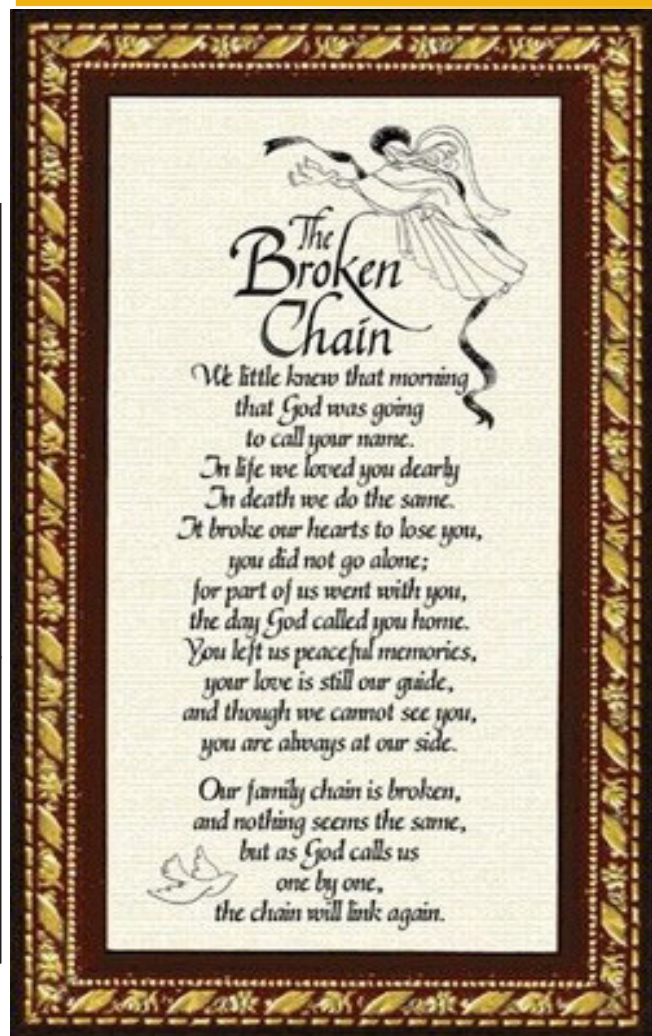

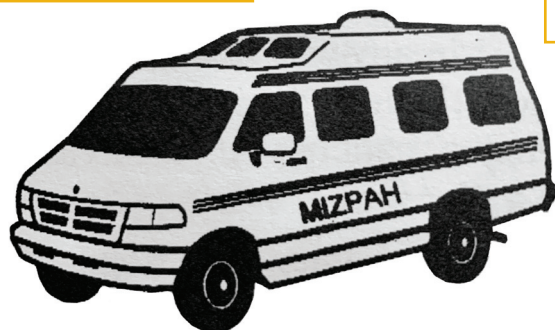
